Masters programmes are offered through Blended mode. In this mode 75% the programme will be offer through distance by the use of MOODLE virtual learning platform accompanied with an optional full-time 2-3 day intensive face-to-face sessions at the end of each trimester. The total duration of coursework is 12 months and dissertation for 6 months (total 18 months). Masters programmes can be studied through the following options.
