Mode of Instruction

The programme is offered through blended/hybrid mode based on the analysis of theoretical texts, cases, and practical issues related to Natural resources assessment and management through interactive face-to-face and e-learning platform known as Modular Object Oriented Dynamic Learning Environment (MOODLE).

Requirements for Admission

To be admitted for **MANRAM**, applicant should have a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent with at least 'B' average, or Postgraduate Diploma and at least two years practical knowledge in a relevant field.

Duration

The duration for completing MANRAM programme is a minimum period of 18 months

Fee Structure

The fees paid to the University are of two categories: **Tuition** and **Non-tuition fees**. The Tuition fee is **220,000/=** Tshs per each coursework or dissertation unit you take. For an Award of a master's degree, you are required to take a minimum of 18 units (including Dissertation units). Hence, a minimum tuition fee for a master's degree is **3,960,000/=** Tshs. The Non-tuition fees including fee/charges paid for items like Registration, ID processing, Quality Assurance, Students Union contribution etc. which give a total of 150,000/= Tshs.
