SCHOLARSHIP FOR HAIRSTYLING & BEAUTY THERAPY TRAINING

Nafasi Opportunity Society (NOS) is a Canadian organization supporting young women in Tanzania who wish to gain vocational skills and require financial assistance. In 2019/20 NOS in collaboration with the Open University of Tanzania (OUT) will sponsor a training programme for Hairstyling and Beauty Therapy. **There are 20 - 25 scholarships, consisting of tuition fee and a stipend to cover transport and lunch for each day of school instruction.**

The nine months training programme, which is accredited by NACTE, will be offered at the Open University of Tanzania and a professional Hairdressing and Beauty school in Dar es Salaam, followed by three months field practice in hair and beauty salons. The program will commence in September 2019.

At the end of this training, learners will become professional hair stylists with skills to work for an established salon or to start their own businesses.

Applicants must be Tanzanian, female aged 18 – 28 years old, with at least Form IV Education.

Scholarships will be awarded based on:

- Financial need
- An interest in the hairdressing profession
- The ability to attend classes from September 2019 to June 2020
