Accepting Applications for Evening Post Graduate Diploma in Education

(PGDE): Dar es Salaam Region

The Department of Educational Foundations (DEF) invites applications from eligible applicants to enroll to an *Evening Post Graduate Diploma in Education (PGDE)* for the academic year 2019/2020 basing in Dar es Salaam region. The PGDE program aims at providing professional qualifications of teaching to students *who did not* have an opportunity to pursue education programmes during their undergraduate studies. Graduates will be in a position to develop professional skills in teaching including classroom investigation, administration and research skills in education. This will enable them to work as educational officers, administrators, managers and decision makers thus excel more in Education Career. Unlike Distance learners, students in evening mode will have face to face instruction in the evening 17.00 to 19.00 Monday to Friday.

2. Requirements for Admission

Eligible applicant should have a Bachelor Degree or Advanced Diploma from a recognized higher learning Institution.

3. Duration of Study

The duration for completing Evening Post Graduate Diploma Program is a minimum of 12 months.

4. Fee Structure

The fees paid to the University are of two categories: Tuition and Non-tuition fees. The Tuition fee for PGDE Evening programme is TSh 100,000/- per each course unit one takes.

For an Award of a PGDE, one is required to take a minimum of 20 units and a maximum of 32 Units for those who lack the content knowledge of the two subjects they will have to teach. Therefore, a minimum tuition fee for the PGDE is TSh 2,000,000/- only. For those with 32 Units the fee is TSh 3,200,000/-.

Please note that there are also some non-tuition fees including fee/charges paid for items such as registration, identity card, quality assurance, students union fee, altogether amounting TSh 150,000/- only.
