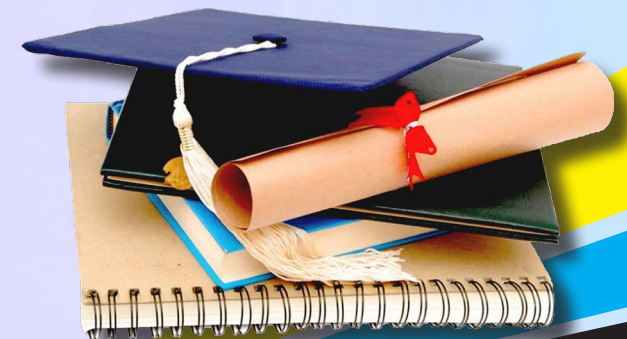

Admission to postgraduate Diploma, Master and PhD degree programmes begins with candidates to place application into one of the postgraduate programmes offered by The Open University of Tanzania. Candidates can apply for admission into The Open University of Tanzania degree programmes through either of the two options:

1. Online Application System (OAS).

Applicants register their personal particulars, academic information, upload scanned copies of transcripts, certificates and a passport size photo. The online application system can be accessed at <https://www.out.ac.tz/postgraduate-2/> or <http://196.216.247.245:8070/index.php/login>

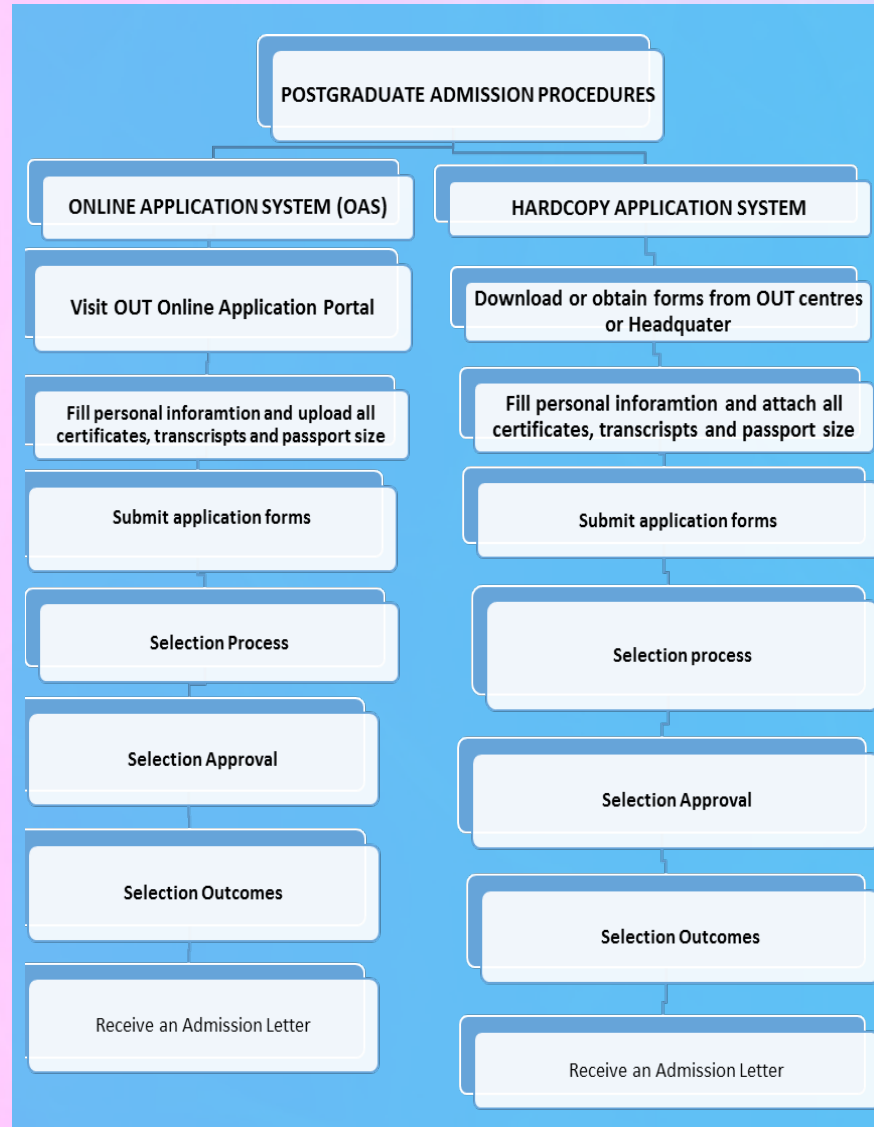
2. Hardcopy Application forms:

Applicants can obtain application forms from the Open University of Tanzania regional centers scattered all over the country or application forms can be downloaded from university websites: <http://www.out.ac.tz/postgraduateapplicationforms>; or can be requested from the Directorate of Postgraduate studies through admissionchuo@gmail.com. The filled forms can be returned to Directorate of Postgraduate Studies with certified copies of their academic certificates, transcripts, passport size photo (with blue background) in person or by snail mail, or by E-mail to the undersigned address.

What should be done after getting an admission letter?

1. The candidate, after getting the admission letter, kindly consult nearby OUT center for activation of registration number, which enable candidates to be registered in the Student Academic Records Information System (SARIS). The process provides candidates SARIS Username and Password.
2. Contact your programme Coordinator to obtain details on the number of courses to be pursued in each semester; the timetable and other matters related to the programme.
3. Register your courses in SARIS to get an invoice (Bill).
4. Get the control number. You can either create it through SARIS or get it from your Center.
5. OUT charges are reasonable amount of fees which is relatively affordable for quality pursuit of academic excellence. Tuition fees for all postgraduate programme are paid through the bank and submit the Bank pay-in-slip to any OUT regional center or headquarter offices to obtain OUT receipt.
6. Get Moodle Username and Password. You can either create it through your SARIS or get it from the OUT regional Center. Now you are ready to start your programme. In case of any inquiry kindly consult a nearby OUT regional center or send an email to dpgs.enquiries@out.ac.tz
