Your field report should be submitted latest by 10th September 2020. Kindly, adhere to time and write substantive reports. Your report will carry 60% of the marks while your supervisor's evaluation will carry the remaining 40%. The content of the report should include the following

3. THE CONTENT OF THE FIELD REPORT

The content of the report should include the following:

- i) An abstract half a page
- ii) Acknowledgement, Table of content and Abbreviations
- iii) Main body- which includes;
 - Vision and Mission of the organization
 - The main functions of the organization
 - Goals and objective of the organization
 - The relationship of the organization functions and librarianship as a field of study
 - Your REAL involvement in the field-what you ACTUALLY do/ learn during the field placement
 - What are the challenges? How did you address them
 - Were your expectations met? Explain.
- iv) Conclusion, Recommendations, References

4. AUTHENTICITY OFREPORTS

A) You should NOT submit plagiarized reports, as this is an academic offence punishable

under the examination irregularities of the OUT. Submit a report which you have written yourself.

- B) The report should be typed (font sizel2; font type— Times New roman and1.5 line space) and the length should be between12 to 15 pages maximum.
- C) MUST use the cover page attached in this announcement. Reports submitted without the cover page will be penalized.

5. FEATURES OF A GOOD REPORT


A good report must have the following qualities
