REGISTRATION FOR SEPT 2020 WRITTEN EXAMINATIONS **Notice to Students**

This is to inform all students that, the University has scheduled **end of year examinations (Written Exams)** from **07th to 25th September 2020** in all OUT Regional Centers and Coordination Centers.

The online system registration for both **Annual Examination (AE)** and **Main Timed Test (MTT)** will be accessible at <http://des.out.ac.tz> (or <http://www.out.ac.tz>) from **19th to 31st August 2020**.

To be able to register online, a candidate is required to pay full tuition fee and all other University fees as per the SARIS invoice printout. As usual, all payments must be made using **Control Number** and through the Government (GePG) payment gateway.

Students are also notified that the examination fee to be paid for **Pen and Paper Examinations** is **TZS 10,000/=** per paper for all **Undergraduate** and **Non-Degree Students**.

Upon online registration, a successful applicant will be provided with an **Examination Hall Ticket (EHT)** which must be submitted to the Director of Regional Center (DRC) together with copies of **Evidence of Fees Payment, Saris Invoice Printout**, and all other required evidences for **EHT endorsement**.

The **Online Course Registration System** is **OPEN** in order to meet the needs of students who got their admission late as well as those who are yet to register for courses. The Examination Timetable will be displayed by next week through University website and on the notice boards.
