ONLINE COURSEWORK ASSESSMENT (ROUND TWO) AND REGISTRATION FOR ON DEMAND (ODEX) EXAMINATIONS

Notice to Students

A: Round TWO Moodle Coursework Assessment – 29th March to 20th April 2021

This is to inform all students that, the University has scheduled Round Two Session for Moodle Coursework Assessment (MCA) to be conducted ONLINE through Moodle Platform from 29th March 2021 to 20th April, 2021. To be eligible for coursework participation, a student must enroll in the course by performing an online course registration for the 2020/2021 academic year, and have paid all the University fees as indicated in the SARIS invoice printout. Students are advised to visit their Moodle account regularly and check with Heads of Departments, and/or Programme/Course coordinators for the departmental coursework assessment plans, structure, question types, and the agreed submission deadlines.

Students are also reminded that all coursework files must be submitted through Moodle platform and shall be subjected for plagiarism check as part of validation process. The invalid submissions which do not fulfill the coursework criteria including plagiarized contents will be discarded straightaway from marking.

B: Special On Demand Examinations (ODEX)

The University has organized a **Special On Demand Annual Examination session** to be conducted in all **OUT Regional Centers** from **Tuesday 27th April, 2021**. The ODEX registration shall be completed through DRC office by filling a **Special ODEX Form** between **24th March 2021** and **14th April 2021**.

Students are reminded to pay **ODEX Fee** of TZS 30,000/= per paper **EXCEPT** those who study Postgraduate and NoN-Degree Programmes which follow **Semester System**, a normal Examination Fee of TZS 20,000/= and TZS 10,000/= per paper shall apply respectively.

The Online Course Registration System is OPEN in order to meet the needs of students who are yet to register for courses.
