ARRANGEMENTS OF EVENING AND EXECUTIVE PROGRAMMES IN 2022

INTRODUCTION

The FBM's evening and executive programs were operational from 2003/2004 and 2007/2008 respectively. The two modes of delivery were no longer operational from the academic year 2016/2017. FBM revived evening mode in 2018-2019 but during 2020/2021 was not executed due to corona pandemic restriction.

OPERATING MODES OF EVENING AND EXECUTIVES PROGRAMMES IN 2022

From 2022, FBM has revived the evening and executive modes of teaching because students and other stakeholders have requested to study under evening and executive modes. However, to be sustainable, the following arrangements will be applied for the evening and executive programmes

- i. Evening and executive modes will be an option and not mandatory
- ii. Students who wish to study the evening and the executive programme should be ready to pay the extra charges i.e TZS 100,000 per unit for the executive programme and TZS 50,000 per unit for the evening programme
- iii. The evening or executive mode will be conducted per course. Hence, students can pay the extra tuition fees for the courses they wish
- iv. The number of break-even students is 15 and 20 for executive and evening programmes respectively
- v. Students will pay the basic tuition fees for blended mode i.e TZS 180,000 per unit in the university account no 011103002558 NBC (with control number) and pay the extra executive and evening charges in the OCB account no 011103033713 NBC (without control number)
- vi. The students who will study through zoom mode will pay 20% less of the normal amount
- vii. The training will be conducted from 5.00 pm to 8.00 pm for two days per week for the period of six weeks for evening programme and 4 full days for executive programme per course
- viii. The coursework assessment will be done immediately after the completion of the trimester. Annual exams will be done one month after the end of the session.
- ix. The course work will comprise 30% online assignments, 20% tests and 50% annual examinations
