A complete mailing address (including email and telephone number) of the author or person to whom all correspondences regarding the manuscript should be addressed must be indicated.

All manuscripts shall further be subjected to editorial review for in-house style, relevance quality of work, and scholarly presentation of content. The editorial Board reserves the right to reject, edit, or shorten any manuscript submitted and approved for publication after review. A decision on every manuscript shall be made promptly and communicated to the authors.
